


Stephen was the clown during the opening event. Bobbing for apples was one of the games.

Worship was spirit-filled, Evangelist Ramiro preached a good sermon. We all prayed for Pastor Santiago and his wife. We also gave away clothes.










The folks at Pastor Reynaldo's church helped Stephen celebrate his 62nd birthday on July 10th.
